

What are the dates and themes for 2021?

We're going to be keeping the themes for next summer the same, with the exception of I week, which will move to A week. You can see all of our dates and themes [HERE](#). Our theme descriptions will be linked below the dates on our website.

What are the rates for Summer 2021?

The rates for next summer are TBD. Once we have determined the rates we will let everyone know.

What do I need to know if I want to roll my tuition over to 2021?

By rolling over your tuition, you will have a credit on your family account. This credit may be used towards any program CSM offers through the end of summer 2021. If you change your mind and would like a refund, you will have until June 1, 2021.

Currently registered campers in **Overnight Camp, Day Camp, and 4 Day Stay:**

- As of now you will have the opportunity to register your camper in 2021 for the week(s) they are currently registered for in 2020. You will then have a chance to change your camper's week prior to general registration opening on November 1st. We will announce that date at a later time. Please note all changes are based on availability at that time.

*If you are currently registered for **any program in I week, Aug 16-21**, you will have the opportunity to register for any open week. Due to the current NYS Regents schedule for 2021, we will be running A-H weeks (instead of B-I).

Currently registered **LIT or CIT campers:**

- We will discuss custom rollover or refund options with your family when we call you.
- Due to the unique circumstances surrounding those programs (age and application process), we still have many logistics to work through and ask for your patience in the meantime.

Currently registered **Overnight Experience campers:**

- As of right now our overnight experience sessions for 2021 are TBD. We will send an email once we have decided on those sessions. You are welcome to register for a 4 Day Stay, Day Camp, or Overnight Camp session if you'd like.

How will refunds work?

Refunds will be processed back to the credit card on file or if you paid by check we will send a check.

What if my camper is on the waitlist?

If your camper is currently on a waitlist, we will copy that waitlist to 2021. For example, if your camper is number 16 on the D week waitlist, they will be number 16 on the D week wait list for 2021. If space becomes available we will contact you to see what you would like to do at that point.

What if my camper will be too old for their program next summer?

This is always a tricky situation to navigate and unfortunately we don't have a lot of wiggle room. The Department of Health requires us to follow certain age guidelines for our programs. We're happy to talk with you about your specific circumstances.

What if my camper received financial assistance in 2020?

If your camper received financial assistance for 2020, we ask that you reapply for 2021. Your deposit and registration will be rolled over if you choose.
