WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Applicant must:

- Be 16 years old by June 26, 2022 or
- Be 15 years old and be in the graduating class of 2024
 - This means sophomore in high school at the time of their application submission and heading into their junior year after summer.
 - If not placed in an LIT session, applicant can enroll as a camper in a week of their choice.



The Leader-in-Training program that serves as the foundation of leadership training at CSM. During their two-week session, LITs participate in creative and engaging workshops in areas of communication, assertiveness, problem solving, and decision making. Participants work both independently and in team settings as they discover their own strengths as future leaders. This program teaches a wide variety of leaderships skills, both camp-specific and relative to the world outside of camp, so it is great for both campers that are interested in being CITs and those that just want to grow their leadership capabilities.

*Please Note: Due to a limited number of spots, candidates must submit an application and be selected for the LIT program.

Counselor-in-Training

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Applicant must:

- Be 17 years old by June 26, 2022 or
- Be 16 years old and be in the graduating class of 2023
 - This means junior in high school at the time of their application submission and heading into their senior year after summer.
 - Option to apply for CIT and LIT. Applicant will fill out CIT application and there will be a place to indicate that they would also like to be considered for LIT if not placed in CIT.
 - This option is not available if the camper has already been through the LIT program.
 - A camper may not be both a LIT and CIT during the same summer.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Counselor-in-Training program is for campers that think they might want to apply to be a counselor and therefore focuses much more on camp-specific leadership. Although the CIT program is considered phase two of CSM's Leadership Development Program, the completion of the LIT program is not a prerequisite for participation. The program runs two weeks with the first really focusing on creating successful peer relationships, working with children of a variety of ages, living in a Christian community and learning to appreciate the importance of taking responsibility. The second week is spent in a camper cabin, gaining hands-on experience acting as an additional counselor (although never left alone).
