Summer 2022 Age Eligibility

STAFF

SUMMER 2022

Applicant must either:

- Be at least 18 years old by June 26, 2022 or
- Be at least 17 years old by June 26, 2022 and be in the graduating class of 2022
 - This means senior in high school at the time of their application submission and therefore graduated by the beginning of summer.
 - Option to apply for both CIT and staff. If offered both a CIT and staff spot, the CIT monies will be refunded in full.

STARTING SUMMER 2023

Applicant must either:

- Be at least 17 years old by June 25, 2023 (regardless of grade) or
- Be at least 17 years old by December 1, 2023 and be in the graduating class of 2024

<u>Please Note</u>: Counselors **must** be 17 years old to be in an overnight cabin. Staff that are 16 years old are required to work on day camp or kitchen staff until they turn 17.

CIT

Applicant must either:

- Be at least 16 years old by June 26, 2022 (regardless of grade) or
- Be at least 16 years old by December 1, 2022 and be in the graduating class of 2024

<u>Please Note</u>: CITs cannot be older than 17 years old during their CIT session. A staff member can only work on day camp or kitchen staff until they turn 17.

LIT

Applicant must either:

- Be at least 15 years old by June 26, 2022 (regardless of grade) or
- Be at least 15 years old by December 1, 2022 and in the graduating class of 2025

<u>Please Note</u>: LITs cannot be older than 16 years old during their CIT session. A staff member can only work on day camp or kitchen staff until they turn 17.
