<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Full change of clothing including socks and undergarments<input type="checkbox"/> Bathing suits *Bathing suits must cover and contain all private areas and be appropriate for the activity. Sports bra style is very popular and preferred (no string ties), please do not pack white bathing suits as they tend to be see-through. Two bathing suits are recommended – putting on a wet suit is the worst!<input type="checkbox"/> Towel<input type="checkbox"/> Plastic bag to put wet/dirty stuff in<input type="checkbox"/> Sneakers<input type="checkbox"/> Water shoes<input type="checkbox"/> Water bottle<input type="checkbox"/> Sunscreen/bug spray<input type="checkbox"/> White t-shirt to tie-dye	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Any items of high personal or monetary value<input type="checkbox"/> Cell phones<input type="checkbox"/> Money<input type="checkbox"/> Toys<input type="checkbox"/> Any device with WiFi, 5G or other internet capabilities (tablets, iPads, Kindles, etc.)<input type="checkbox"/> Valuables (watches, jewelry, etc.)
